- **What we offer:**

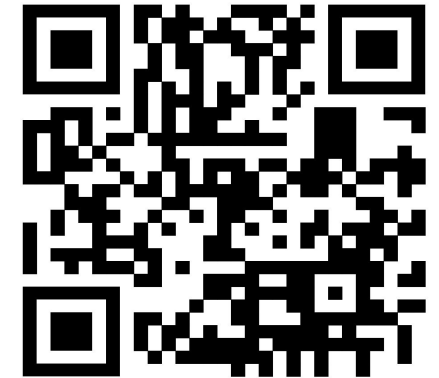

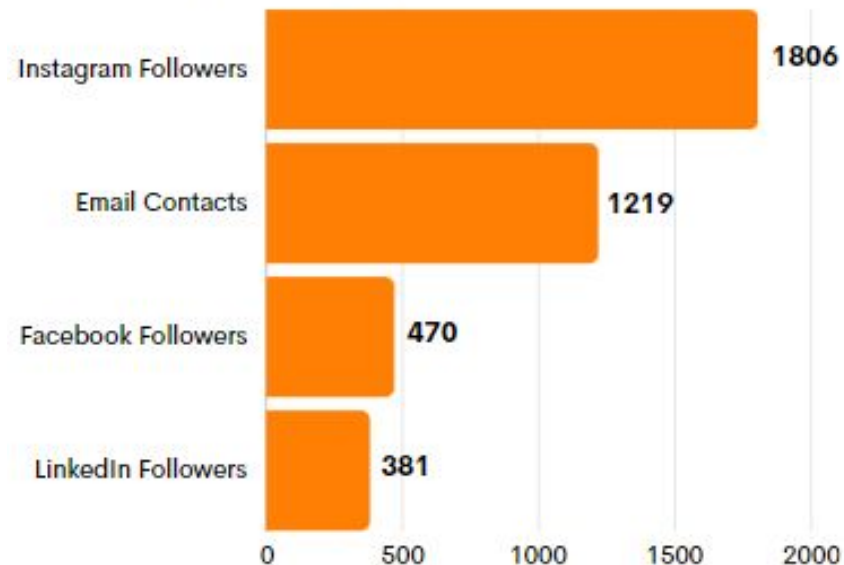

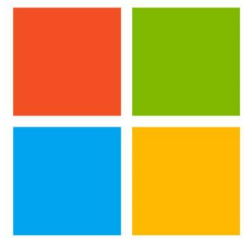
